

You've discovered the largest privately owned deep-water marina on Florida's west coast, right in your own backyard.


The Burnt Store Marina & Country Club's average channel depth of 7 feet can accommodate boats up to 70 feet in length with complete marina, security, electrical, water and sanitary services, including a pump-out station.


No less than 425 slips — available by day, week, month or year — offer direct deep-water access to scenic Charlotte Harbor and the sporting waters of the Gulf of Mexico beyond. Other marina services include a Ship's Store — with groceries, bait and tackle — fuel, yacht maintenance, haul-out service, engine repair, indoor and outdoor storage, plus

retroooms, showers, laundromat and swimming pool. Burnt Store also features powerboat and sailboat rentals, sightseeing excursions, yacht sales, fishing charters and more.

Boca Grande Pass, a quick boat ride from Burnt Store, offers the finest tarpon fishing in the world. You'll catch snook, redfish, trout, amberjack and snapper. Or, venture out into the Gulf to haul in grouper or even an occasional sailfish.

Burnt Store Marina & Country Club is also home to the sparkling new Platinum Point Yacht Club and features hotel accommodations right on site.


